River Thames – Henley Reach Navigation and mooring directions

12:00 Monday 5 July to 06:00 Friday 23 July 2010

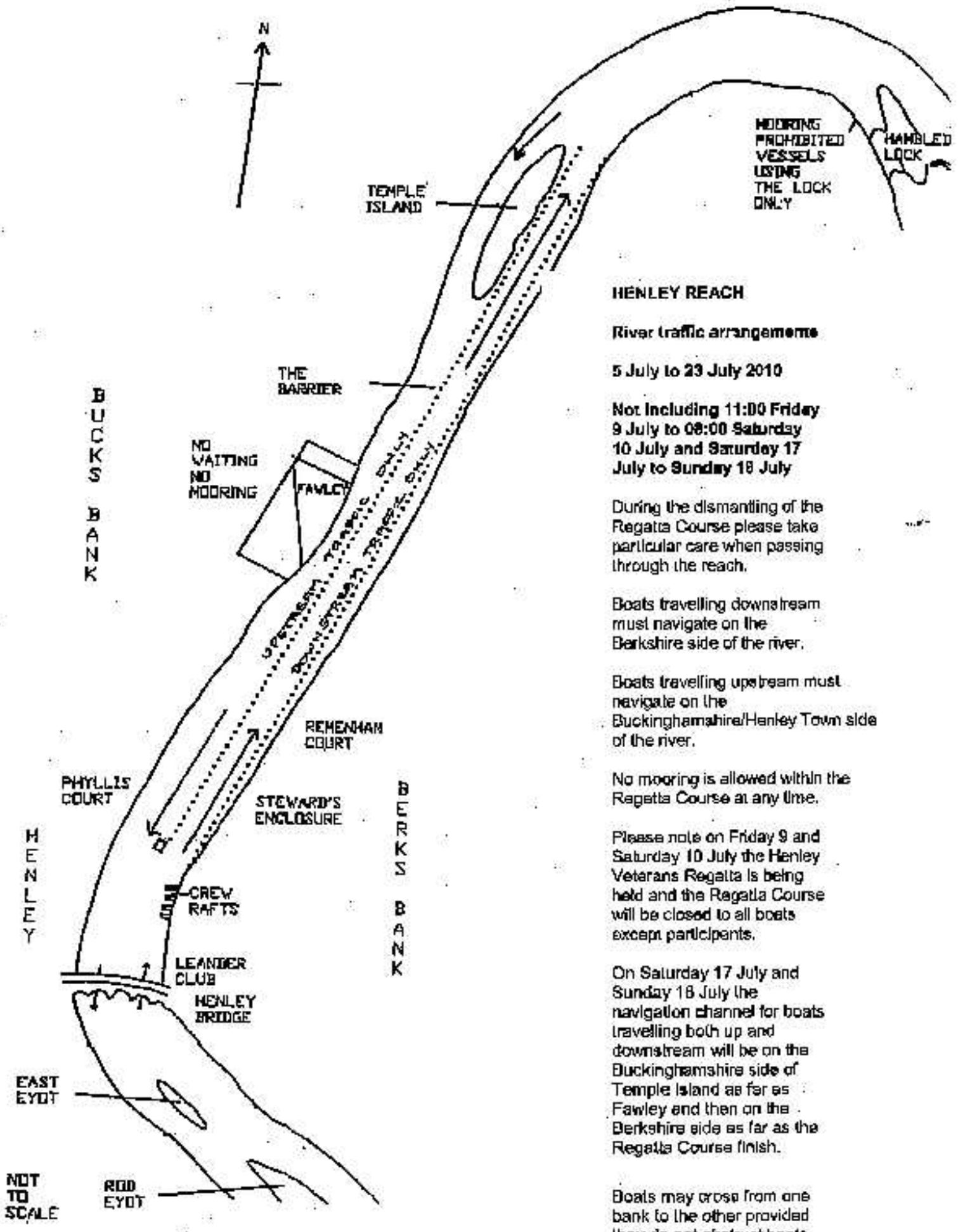
Those in charge of boats must conform with these directions and with any special directions which, at the discretion of the harbourmaster, may be required in particular circumstances during these dates.

While the Henley Royal Regatta course is being dismantled, the following restrictions apply to **all boats** navigating between Henley Bridge and the downstream end of Temple Island (except between 11:00 on Friday 9 July and 18:00 on Saturday 24 July and on Saturday 17 July to Sunday 18 July):

- All boats travelling downstream must navigate within the regatta course booms from the regatta finish to the barrier.
- All boats travelling upstream must navigate on the Buckinghamshire/Oxfordshire side of the regatta course.
- Any boat can cross the course from one side of the river to the other provided they do not obstruct other boats or impede the regatta being held on the 9 and 10 July or the boat rally being held on 17 and 18 July.
- No boats can moor within the regatta course, to the bank in the vicinity of the former Fawley Court Boathouse or to the adjacent regatta course booms at any time.
- No boats can moor unattended to the regatta course booms, plies or boxes.

River traffic arrangements

10 July and Saturday 17
July to Sunday 18 July**

During the dismantling of the Regatta Course please take particular care when passing through the reach.

Boats travelling downstream must navigate on the Berkshire side of the river.

Boats travelling upstream must navigate on the Buckinghamshire/Henley Town side of the river.

No mooring is allowed within the Regatta Course at any time.

Please note on Friday 9 and Saturday 10 July the Henley Veterans Regatta is being held and the Regatta Course will be closed to all boats except participants.

On Saturday 17 July and Sunday 18 July the navigation channel for boats travelling both up and downstream will be on the Buckinghamshire side of Temple Island as far as Fawley and then on the Berkshire side as far as the Regatta Course finish.

Boats may cross from one bank to the other provided they do not obstruct boats travelling up or downstream.
